Treatment foster care (TFC) is a more intensive, comprehensive approach to the traditional family foster care system. Children ages birth to eighteen who are referred by Children Services for TFC have experienced trauma, abuse, neglect or abandonment. Some children have additional medical needs while others have developmental delays or disabilities. As a result of these experiences, children often present behavioral and emotional challenges severe enough that they are most effectively addressed in TFC using a team approach.

At Dungarvin, we believe that well-trained and well-supported foster parents provide the most effective intervention possible to children in care and their families. With the help of our expert staff, Dungarvin's treatment foster parents offer individualized treatment in their own home where youth can participate in family and community activities, benefit from placement stability, and create meaningful relationships.
